

CVWD – New Procedures

Beginning May 1, 2016, the Coachella Valley Water District (CVWD) will require a developer's "Engineer of Record" to provide the calculations for water service and meter sizing on domestic water construction plans. CVWD hosted two workshops in April 2016 that reviewed this new requirement. The Development Design Manual on CVWD's website has been updated to address this new requirement.
